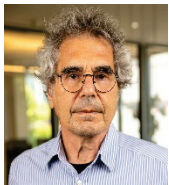

[Daniel Hausman](#) is a Research Professor in the Center for Population–Level Bioethics (CPLB), Department of Health Behavior, Society and Policy. He is also a faculty member within the Rutgers Department of Philosophy. Professor Hausman’s research addresses issues at the boundaries between economics and philosophy and currently focuses on the ethical appraisal of using cost-effectiveness information to guide health policy.



[Tayfun Sönmez](#) is a Professor of Economics at Boston College. Professor Sönmez is specialized in market design, with an emphasis on its applications in matching markets. He is best known for his contributions to the design and analyses of transplant organ allocation policies, pandemic medical resource allocation and affirmative action schemes, among other applications.
